

The above-entitled cause of action was scheduled for hearing July 2, 2008 at the Ethics and Rules Conference Room, Window Rock, Arizona, Navajo Nation. The Complaining Party, Johnny C. Begay, appeared for this hearing, with the Navajo Nation. The Respondent however failed to appear although properly notified, in writing, of the date, place and time of the hearing. Concerning this notice, Respondent was personally served on June 9, 2008 by Mr. Ron Largo, Investigator, Navajo Nation Ethics and Rules Office. *Return of Service* and accompanying letter advising Respondent of the hearing are attached hereto as *Exhibits "A" and "B"* respectively. The complaint and all other supporting documents served upon the Respondent are incorporated herein by this reference.

Pursuant to *Rule 15, Nonappearance, Administrative Hearing Rules*, the Navajo Nation Ethics and Rules Committee hereby enters judgment in favor of the Complaining Party and against the Respondent. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall immediately be removed from all elective positions with the Navajo Nation, including the position of Secretary Treasurer, Red Valley Chapter. He shall be disqualified from and shall not be eligible for any elective position of the Navajo Nation for a period of five years, beginning on the date of this order; and,
2. Respondent shall not be eligible for *employment* with the Navajo Nation for a period of five years, such period to begin immediately; and,
3. Respondent shall pay as restitution \$3,617.53 to the Red Valley Chapter. This amount shall be paid through the Ethics and Rules Office and shall be immediately payable; and,
4. For his nonappearance, the Committee finds that the Respondent has shown contempt for proceedings of the Ethics and Rules Committee. For this contempt, the Committee imposes a fine of \$500.00, payable immediately through the Ethics and Rules Office.

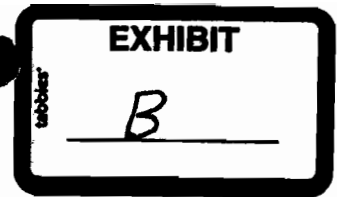
