
**Order Accepting
Stipulation**

The parties in the above entitled cause of action appeared before the Ethics and Rules Committee of the Navajo Nation Council on March 08, 2007. A Stipulated agreement dated February 27, 2007 was presented to the Ethics and Rules Committee for approval. (See Exhibit "A".) Upon consideration of the agreement, the Committee hereby accepts the settlement as proposed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDER:

1. The Stipulated Agreement is accepted and shall be incorporated herein.
2. Respondent shall start monthly restitution payment beginning April 16, 2007. Restitution payments shall be made through the Ethics and Rules Office.
3. Among other stipulated, Respondent shall be ineligible for public elective office for a period five (5) years.

STIPULATION

The undersigned parties in the above-entitled cause of action Stipulate and agree on the following:

1. The Respondent, Eddie Enditto, former Chapter Secretary/Treasurer of the Navajo Nation with the Thoreau Chapter, Eastern Agency, and is subject to the provisions of the *Navajo Nation Ethics in Government Law and other applicable Navajo Nation Law*;
2. Based upon investigation by the Ethics and Rules Office, an Ethics complaint has been filed with the Ethics and Rules Committee, factual violations of the Navajo Nation *Ethics in Government Law* by Respondent is charged with §3752, *Unauthorized Compensation Or Benefit For Official Acts*; 2 NNC §3753, *Unauthorized Personal Use of Property Or Funds Of The Navajo Nation*, 26 NNC §1001 (B) 3,(H), (I) 26 NNC §2003 (D), (E);
3. The Respondent has read the proposed Ethics complaint concerning the facts stated in the Complaint to be filed with the Ethics and Rules Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, and for the purposes of these proceedings hereby knowingly and voluntarily admits each and every fact contained in the Complaint;
4. For the purpose of resolving this Complaint, Respondent further agrees not to contest the facts established in the course of the Ethics and Rules investigation and as stated in the Complaint and admitted to the illegal activities by Respondent;

5. Having read the facts in the complaint, and being fully advised as to the legal consequences, Respondent knowingly and voluntarily waives his right to a hearing before the Ethics and Rules Committee, or any other forum or court to contest the facts contained in the Complaint;
6. For the purpose of resolving this Complaint, Respondent hereby waives his right to contest or to appeal a finding by the Committee that he violated the *Ethics in Government Law* as stated in the Complaint;
7. The Respondent admits to each illegal activities and stipulates that the Committee has jurisdiction and is legally authorized to proceed with sanctions against Respondent for violations of the *Ethics in Government Law*;
8. For resolving this complaint, Respondent agrees that he will pay restitution in the total amount of \$2,398.17. The Respondent, also agrees to begin payment of restitution in April, 2007, at the rate of \$150.00 per month, and thereafter each month as stipulated until the set amount is paid in full to Thoreau Chapter;
9. Specifically the Respondent waives the following rights and procedures;
 - a). The right to respond in writing or otherwise to the complaint;
 - b). The right to receive additional formal notice of the complaint;
 - c). The right for the Ethics and Rules Office to conduct any additional investigation before proceeding to hearing and sanctions;
 - d). The right to appear before the committee for a formal presentation of the allegations and any other rights Respondent may have in relation to questioning the authority or jurisdiction of the Committee to proceed formally on the basis of the Complaint and this Stipulation:
 - e). The right to have a hearing scheduled and to be given at least 20 days to prepare for a hearing on the merits of the Complaint;
 - f). The right to any oral or written advice as to the hearing process; to call witnesses, or to present evidence or use exhibits in presenting any defense to the facts of the Complaint;
 - g). The right to have a full adversarial hearing and to take advantage of any and all safeguards which may be afforded to him by the hearing process;

- h). The right to present any additional preliminary matters prior to the exercise of discretion by the Committee in accepting this Stipulation and rendering its final sanctions pursuant to the terms of this Stipulation and the Stipulated Order;
- i). The Respondent knowingly and voluntarily waives his right to legal counsel in this administrative hearing and proceedings;
- j). The right to appeal any decision or sanctions imposed by Committee.

10. The Respondent knowingly agrees that he will be ineligible for Navajo Nation elective public office for a period of five (5) years;


11. The foregoing Stipulation and *admissions of the illegal activities* by the Respondent are all conditioned on their acceptance by the Ethics and Rules Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, and their incorporation in the Final Order as a final resolution of the Complaint;

12. In the event the Committee does not accept all of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation and Agreement by the parties, it shall be withdrawn without prejudice to either party to this Stipulation and Agreement, and the Committee may then proceed to schedule a hearing on the merits of the Complaint, or any Amended Complaint which may be filed by the Ethics and Rules Office;


13. The Respondent, Eddie Enditto, fully understands the contents of the Stipulation herein;


